Commerce Bank of Folsom Changes Name, Adds Branch

FOLSOM, Calif., August 01, 2008 – Today, Commerce Bank of Folsom officially changes its name to Sierra Vista Bank. As a result of the name change, the bank will also change its CUSIP number and trading symbol. The new CUSIP number is 82651B 105, and the new trading symbol is pending assignment by the OTC Bulletin Board.

In addition, the Bank has received regulatory approval for its expansion into Cameron Park. After only 1.5 years of operation, the Bank will open its second branch at 3311 Coach Lane in the Sam's Town Marketplace in Cameron Park. The branch is expected to open during the fourth quarter of 2008. Sierra Vista Bank's headquarters will remain at 1710 Prairie City Road in Folsom. This expansion comes on the heels of the Bank's announcement of the appointment of Gary D. Gall, as Chairman of the Board, pending regulatory approval.

With these recent changes, Sierra Vista Bank is positioning itself to broaden its reach to communities throughout the Highway 50 Corridor and fill the community bank void left by acquisitions consummated in the past few years.
